II. FINANCIAL CONDITIONS

1. Conference participation

The fee for participation is 15 Euro (covering the costs of publishing the abstracts; preparing hand-outs; postal fees for mailing one copy of conference proceedings to the author).

2. Participation by correspondence

The fee for participation by correspondence is 15 Euro (covering the costs of publishing the abstracts and postal fees for mailing one copy of published conference proceedings to the author).

3. REQUIREMENTS TO THE ABSTRACT

Abstracts formatting requirements:

1. We accept only the works which had not been published before.

2. Abstracts should be written in Ukrainian (by citizens of Ukraine), in Russian or English (by foreign citizens).

3. Abstracts should be mailed by post to the address of the organizing committee; the letter should contain one copy of the printed abstract signed by the author and a CD-R with an electronic version of the abstract. Bachelor's and master's students must also indicate the name of their scientific advisor and submit his/her review note.

4. Abstracts should be saved in MS Word, A4 page format with 20 mm margins set for top, bottom and sides, typed in Times New Roman, 12 pt, with 1.5 spacing.

5. Abstracts should be no longer than 4 pages in length, including figures and tables. The number of authors should not exceed 2 persons.

6. General outline of the abstract:

- Name(s) of the author(s), organization and city should be typed in top right corner (in capital letters, without abbreviations).

– The title of abstract should be typed in capital letters and centered.

7. We would appreciate the minimal use of illustrative materials. All figures should be grouped as a single object.

8. References should be numbered by order of appearance in the text and listed in the end of the abstract according to the established requirements. Reference numbers and pages should be written in brackets.

9. Abstracts that do not meet the above-mentioned requirements or arrive late will not be accepted.
